### PADRE SERRA SAYS:

You should have some beliefs on these perceptions based upon your reading, your study and your dialogue with other Catholics. In *The Responsible Person in Society*, Fr. John Pawlikowski, OSM a professor of social ethics, asks the reader: "What sets apart the moral vision of Christians in general and of Catholics in particular? Who is the Christian, according to this moral tradition? What kind of person is the Christian called to become? How are the principles of Catholic and Christian moral theology applicable in daily life and to specific dilemmas and conflict situations?" Pray for vocations.
