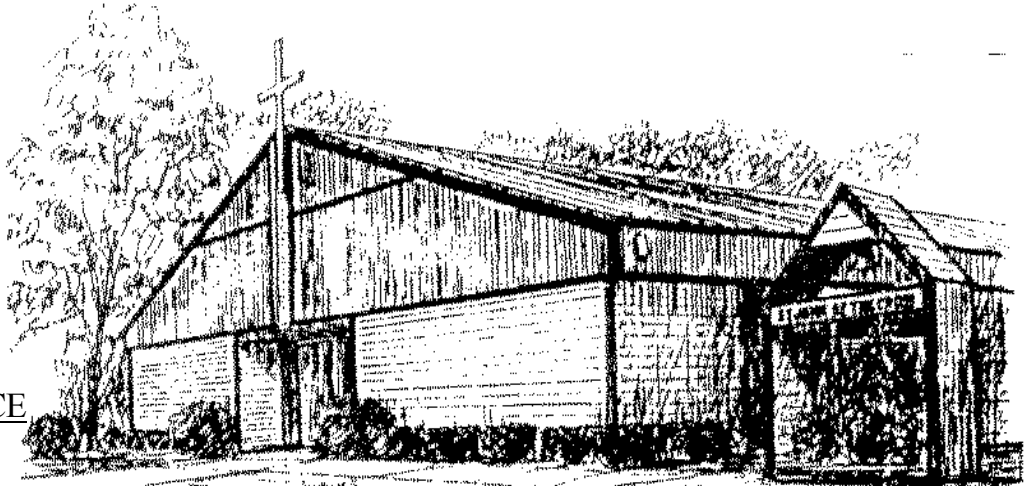

He hadn't known how much he like children; now hundreds of kids know he's ticklish behind the knees. This is not a dead-end job. He is learning every day. He is a priest.
